



Dear Our Lady of Fatima Parishioners,

Catholic Christian OUTREACE

Hello everyone, I hope you're all doing well! This is Marlie Wolensky, I am writing to tell you about a mission project that I will be participating in this summer with Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO). CCO is a university movement dedicated to encouraging young people to develop their relationship with Christ through weekly faith studies, large group meetings, retreats, conferences, and Christian community.

A bit about my story: I joined CCO in September of 2023 and my life has changed so much since then. Although I always went to church and did all the things a good Catholic should do, I didn't truly know Jesus. Last semester I took CCO's Discovery faith study and my eyes were opened to the beauty of a life lived for Jesus. I attended my first ever adoration night in October. I was too afraid to talk to anyone, I didn't even know anyone, so I asked God to send someone to pray for me. Immediately, one of the missionaries, Bethany, walked over to me and told me that God had asked her to come pray for me. I started crying on the spot, I have never had a prayer answered so quickly. At that moment I knew for sure that God is real and he loves me. Since then I have grown as a disciple, leading a Discovery study and accompanying four protestant girls closer to Christ. One of the girls came to our most recent adoration night and cried, saying she had never felt more loved than she did that night. Jesus is changing the world through CCO and I have been so blessed to be a part of it!

Another aspect of CCO is to challenge students to consider volunteering for a summer to do missions. In the words of Saint John Paul II: "Faith is strengthened when it is given to others!" I have been selected as one of twenty-one young adults who will travel as pilgrims and missionaries to Donegal and Waterford, Ireland. As pilgrims we will be visiting the Marian Apparition site in Knock and staying with The Divine Mercy Centre and Holy Family Mission. As missionaries, we have been asked by Bishop Alphonsus to come to Waterford to grow the parishioners in discipleship so they in turn can lead people closer to Jesus. We will be trained in valuable evangelistic skills that I will be able to use when I return home to my own diocese and campus. I'm so excited about this opportunity to serve God and the international church and to grow in my faith through this experience! I know that this experience will be a great spiritual investment in my life, and I am looking forward to going and coming back and putting everything I learn into action.

To participate in this mission project, we are responsible to raise a portion of the cost through tax-deductible donations to cover training, accommodations, food and transportation, the amount is \$4900.
