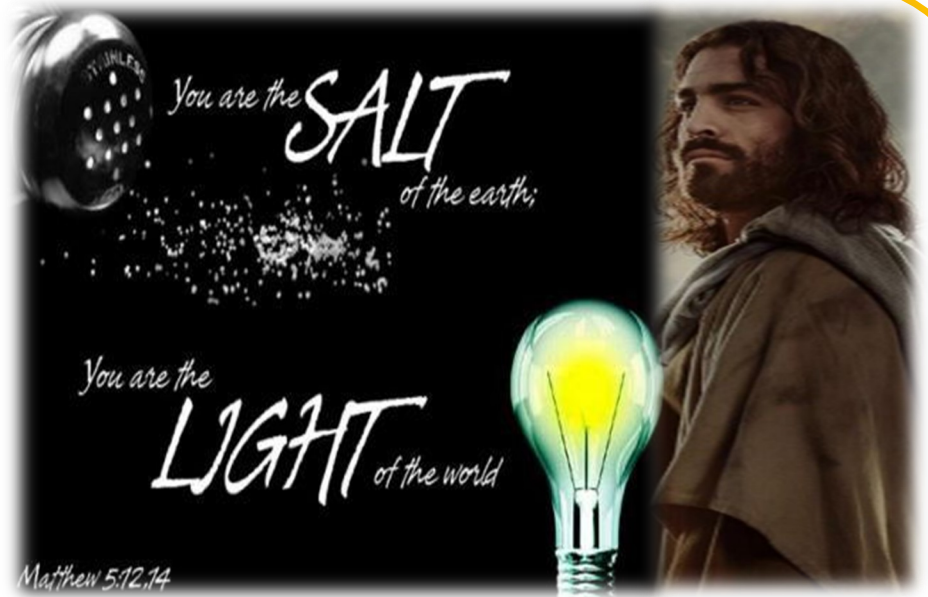

Citizens Petition to the Legislature of Saskatchewan to enact Conscience Rights Protection

Redvers CWL—is encouraging everyone to sign the petition forms at the back of our churches calling on the provincial government to enact legislation to protect conscience rights for all medical practitioners. The coercion, intimidation, or other forms of pressure intended to force physicians and healthcare workers and institutions to become parties in medical assistance in dying (MAiD) directly or through effective referral is a violation of fundamental freedoms of conscience. The protection for medical professionals is necessary for patients to know they are receiving the best care possible. While provincial governments and medical associations were obligated to implement MAiD following its de-criminalization by the Federal Liberal Government, provincial legislatures can create a legal framework (as the legislature of Manitoba has done) to protect the conscience rights of medical professionals who refuse to participate in MAiD as well as prevent professional regulatory bodies from requiring their members to participate in it. **Please Note:** There is no minimum age requirement for anyone signing the petition.



St Paul Miki/Companions—Japanese Martyrs—February 6

Paul was the son of a Japanese military leader. He was born at Tounucumada, Japan, was educated at the Jesuit college of Anziquama, joined the Jesuits in 1580, and became known for his eloquent preaching. He was crucified on February 5 with twenty-five other Catholics during the persecution of Christians under the Taiko, ruler of Japan in the name of the emperor. Among the Japanese laymen who suffered the same fate were: Francis, a carpenter who was arrested while watching the executions and then crucified; Gabriel, the nineteen year old son of the Franciscan's porter; Leo Kinuya, a twenty-eight year old carpenter from Miyako; Diego Kisai; Joachim Sakakibara, cook for the Franciscans at Osaka; Peter Sukejiro, sent by a Jesuit priest to help the prisoners, who was then arrested; Cosmas Takeya from Owari, who had preached in Osaka; and Ventura from Miyako, who had been baptized by the Jesuits, gave up his Catholicism on the death of his father, became a bonze, and was brought back to the Church by the Franciscans. They were all canonized as the Martyrs of Japan in 1862. Their feast day is February 6th.
