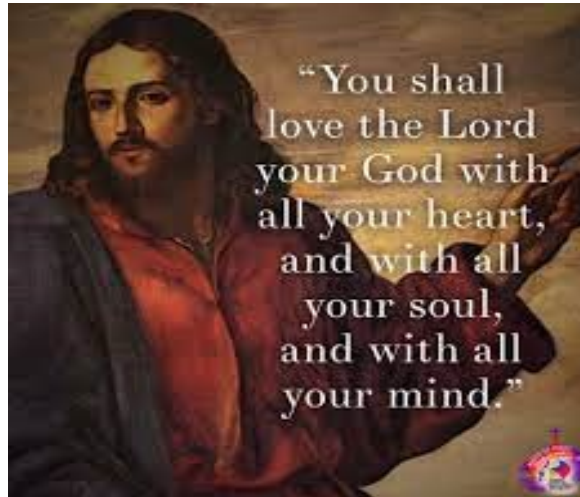

## First Saturday Devotion *to the Immaculate Heart of Mary*

### Why Communal First Saturday Devotions?

In reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary for the salvation of souls and peace in the world. ### Why are there 5 First Saturdays?

There are 5 First Saturdays because as Jesus told Sr. Lucia there are 5 kinds of offenses and blasphemies against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

1. Against the Immaculate Conception of Mary
2. Against Mary’s Virginity
3. Against Mary’s Divine Maternity and her Motherhood of all mankind
4. Turning children against Mary as their heavenly Mother
5. Against Mary’s Sacred images
